

Position Title: Medical Practitioner

The successful applicant will be a Sub-Investigator on the study working alongside the Principal Investigator, the Clinical Trial Coordinator and other research staff.

The Role

The Medical Practitioner will be responsible for the medical oversight of trial participants including: obtaining informed consent from research participants, obtaining medical history, conducting physical examinations, performing and interpreting ECG, phlebotomy skills and adherence to clinical trial protocols working within current good clinical practice guidelines.

Essential Requirements

It is essential that applicants is currently registered as a medical practitioner with AHPRA, and should have at least 3 years post graduate experience in the hospital setting or in general practice.

Desirable criteria

The successful applicant must display excellent communication, interpersonal and organisational skills, and the ability to work as part of a team.

This position is ideal for practitioners with an interest in work options outside hospital and GP settings. The position is approximately 2 days a week with flexibility in the days and hours.
