

Position Title: Medical Practitioner

We are seeking a part-time Medical Practitioner to assist with the conduct of our clinical trials in Alzheimer's disease. The clinical trials are investigator-initiated research projects and clinical trials sponsored by international pharmaceutical companies.

The role offers flexible working arrangements and salary packaging.

The successful applicant will be a Sub-Investigator on the study, working alongside the Principal Investigator, the Clinical Trial Coordinator and other research staff.

The Role

The Medical Practitioner will be responsible for the medical oversight of trial participants, including obtaining informed consent from research participants, obtaining medical history, conducting physical examinations, performing and interpreting ECG, phlebotomy and adherence to clinical trial protocols whilst working within good clinical practice guidelines.

Essential Requirements

It is essential that the applicant is currently registered as a medical practitioner with AHPRA and should have at least three years of post-graduate experience in the hospital setting or in general practice.

Desirable criteria

The successful applicant must display excellent communication, interpersonal and organisational skills, and the ability to work as part of a team.

This position is ideal for practitioners interested in work options outside hospital and GP settings. The position is two days a week, ideally Monday and Friday, with some flexibility in the hours.
