The role offers flexible working arrangements and salary packaging for 2 days per week. No clinical trial experience is needed. This position is ideal for practitioners with an interest in work options outside hospital and GP settings.

The successful applicant will be a Sub-Investigator on the study working alongside the Principal Investigator, the Clinical Trial Coordinator and other research staff.

### **The Role**

The Medical Practitioner will be responsible for the medical oversight of trial participants including: obtaining informed consent from research participants, obtaining medical history, conducting physical examinations, performing and interpreting ECG, phlebotomy and adherence to clinical trial protocols whilst working within good clinical practice guidelines.

It is essential that applicants are currently registered as a medical practitioner with AHPRA, and should have at least 3 years post graduate experience in the hospital setting or in general practice.

The successful applicant must display excellent communication, interpersonal and organisational skills, and the ability to work as part of a team.
